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## Hanover County 4-H PowerPoint Presentation Design Contest

The 4-Hers are required to create a PowerPoint Presentation. Judging is based on the 4-Her's use of the PowerPoint tool and not on the subject content of their presentation. However, the 4-Her must choose the 4-H appropriate subject matter. Cloverbuds (ages 5 - 8) presentation length should be 1 - 2 minutes. Any Cloverbuds that participate will be awarded a participation ribbon. Scored presentations are as follows: 2 - 5 minutes in length for Juniors (ages 9 - 11), 3 - 6 minutes for Intermediate (ages 12 - 13), and 5 - 7 minutes in length for Seniors (ages 14 - 18).

Should technical difficulty occur, students are judged on their ability to keep their cool and improvise in this competition 70% of the 4-Hers score is based on their PowerPoint program quality and 30% on the member's presentation. Please refer to the attached judging sheet for a detailed explanation of the judging criteria.

- Clear and concise
- Logical progression of ideas

Text Elements Criteria: 15 Points

• Easy-to-read

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- Point size varies appropriately for headings and text
  - 7x7 Rule is followed (not too much text)
    - 7x7 Rule: no more than 7 words per line, and 7 lines per slide
- No spelling, punctuation, or grammatical errors

Appearance / Layout Criteria: 15 Points

- Layout is visually appealing and supports the overall message
- Appropriate use of background and theme
- Logo, footer, and slide # included on all slides

Transitions/Effects Criteria: 10 Points

- All transitions and animation enhance the presentation without distraction
- Sounds and other media do not distract the audience
- All effects are not distracting and are appropriate to the topic and overall theme

Eye Contact / Visual Presentation Criteria: 30 points

- Great eye contact with the whole audience
- Does not stare or read the screen
- Adds a great amount of information besides what is on the slides
- Shows interest and enthusiasm
- Speaks with a clear voice with an appropriate volume
- Does not use verbal fillers
